## Directory of NSAs in Hong Kong

An updated version of the directory of National Sports Associations in Hong Kong was published and delivered to the sports community in early October. With a comprehensive list of contacts of all major stakeholders in Hong Kong sport, including the SDB, ASF&OC, the NSAs, and other district sports bodies, users can easily identify the names and titles of officials and staff for the individual organisations.

## Facility Charges for NSAs

Despite the increase in maintenance cost of facilities at the Sports Institute and the Sports House, the SDB has not only decided to freeze rates for most of the training and meeting facilities this year, but offered the NSAs, the most frequent users, special discounts up to 30% off for accommodation and catering services at the Sports Institute. ## IT support to NSAs

The upgrade of both computer hardware and software for NSAs located at the Sports House is in progress. Phase I of the project has already been completed for 20 NSAs. Systems of the remaining 20 NSAs will be upgraded in Phase II, which is expected to be completed in October.

Up-to-date information technology ensures not only efficient and cost-effective management for NSAs, but also provides the winning edge over other contenders worldwide to maintain quality services.

## Research Highlights

With an increase in public awareness and participation in sports, the idea of sports injury receives more and more concerns from the general public. To review the pattern and causes of sports injuries, the SDB commissioned the Department of Physical Education of the Baptist University to a sports injury study in school settings.

It was reported that about 60 per cent of the injuries are not serious and was confined to sprain, abrasion and strain. Improper, insufficient or lack of warm-up are the common causes in most cases. By prescribing specific stretching and strengthening exercise on Achilles tendon, hamstring muscle and quadriceps muscle, the above injuries could be prevented. A research highlight has been sent to the NSAs.

## Draft Youth Sports Policy

The Youth Sports Policy, initiated by the SDB, aims at providing guidelines for youth sports development in Hong Kong as well as enhancing coordination among organisations concerned. Upon completion of the first draft paper on the policy, inputs from NSAs are cordially invited. The draft paper on the policy was sent to the associations in early October. As a major promoter of sport to the youth, NSAs'

## SportEd Programme

To broaden the knowledge of teachers and students in sports, a SportEd Programme under the Hongkong Telecom *GO!SPORT* umbrella has been introduced by the SDB. Activities in Phase I of the programme have been scheduled in November. Eight sport-specific activities on windsurfing, rowing, ice-skating, underwater, badminton, basketball, cycling, and roller-skating will be offered to participants. Another part of the programme will focus on general sport theory. Ideas on how to select appropriate sports gears will be covered in this phase.

All the activities have been specially designed by NSAs to cater the interests and needs of school teachers and students. ## Family and Sports Campaign

With the support of six NSAs including the Hong Kong Badminton Association, Hong Kong Basketball Association, Hong Kong Ruby Football Union, Hong Kong Squash and Hong Kong Table Tennis Association, a "Meet the Squad and Sports Challenge Day" was held at the Sports Institute on 26 September 1998. Over two hundred participants from fifty families toured around the facilities at the Shatin training complex before challenging the skills of a group of elite athletes.
