## The Best Ever Results at the Asian Games

Hong Kong athletes clinched 5 gold, 6 silver and 6 bronze medals at the 1998 Asian Games. A total of HK\$5,150,000 was awarded to medallists under the “1998 Asian Games Athlete Incentive Awards Scheme”, introduced by the SDB and sponsored by American International Assurance Co (Bermuda) Ltd, Caltex Companies (Greater China) Ltd and Standard Chartered Bank. A prize presentation was held at the Government House on 15 January and the SDB also took the opportunity to celebrate the New Year with all major stakeholders in sports.

## Sports Marketing Course

The first Sports Marketing Course, organised by Sports International Limited, completed on 14 December 1998. Participants included NSA officials and staff. Nine sessions were conducted with speakers from the corporate sector and the sports marketing field.

## Best Present from Christmas

Instead of sending out Christmas cards, ABN Amro Bank took a more environmental and meaningful approach to greet their clients by placing an advertisement in newspaper. The card production cost of HK\$20,000 had been saved and the sum was donated to the Hong Kong Sports Association for the Mentally Handicapped.

## Sports Injuries Workshop

A series of sports injuries workshops was organised by the Coach Education Department at the Sports Institute on 8, 15, 17 & 18 December. Speakers, including Dr. P.S. Wong, Dr. H.F. Lung

and Mr Purple Tse, shared their professional knowledge with more than 60 participants from various NSAs. The three professionals lectured on first aid treatment of different body parts such as head, neck, chest, abdominal, upper and lower limbs as well as the treatment of common medical problems.

## Performance Related Pay System (PRPS)

With a view to introduce the PRPS to all NSAs subvented staff in 1999/2000, the SDB has produced a set of guidelines of the system. A briefing was held at the Jockey Club Lecture Theatre, Sports House on 14 January, with details of the system being presented to NSAs.

## Staff Motivation

A luncheon workshop on “How to Motivate your staff to Increase Productivity” has been scheduled to be held at the Sports House in late January. A total of 30 seats are available to NSAs officials and staff members for enrolment. For details, please contact Suzanne Choi at 2504 8588.

## Overseas Study Trips

As part of the NSA Professional Training Programme, NSA officials and staff are welcome to initiate overseas study trips in relation to their sports. Three NSAs made their request. Two staff members from the Hong Kong Rugby Union have been granted approval to attend two study courses in coach education in Australia, while a staff member from the Judo Association of Hong Kong, China, will attend a judo championships in Japan in January.
